ALABAMA LEGAL NOTICE

Beginning February 1, 2007, the regulation of your telephone service by the Alabama Public Service Commission will be changed in accordance with provisions of Alabama Code section 37-2A-4, which limits the commission's jurisdiction over retail telecommunications services and bundled service offerings. This is to advise you that the rates, terms and conditions for the services provided to you by Deltacom/BTI will not otherwise change and will continue as provided for in individual customer agreements and company tariffs, as applicable. Company tariffs are posted on our website at www.deltacom.com. Also, additional information is available on the website or you may call Customer Care.

These important changes in Alabama law for telecommunications services include, in part:

Limited regulation of retail services –

Section 37-2A-4(g): Beginning Feb 1, 2007, the commission shall not have any jurisdiction...or authority...over any retail telecommunications service or any existing bundled offering, except over (i) basic telephone service and optional telephone features and (ii) existing contract offerings, which were entered into prior to August 1, 2006, for the duration of those contract offerings, unless otherwise agreed to by the affected customer.

Section 37-2A-4(h): Tariffs for the services remaining subject to the commission's jurisdiction shall remain valid and in effect until the date its jurisdiction ceases as stated in subsection (g), and until the last existing contract offering has expired or has been replaced by a new contract offering.
